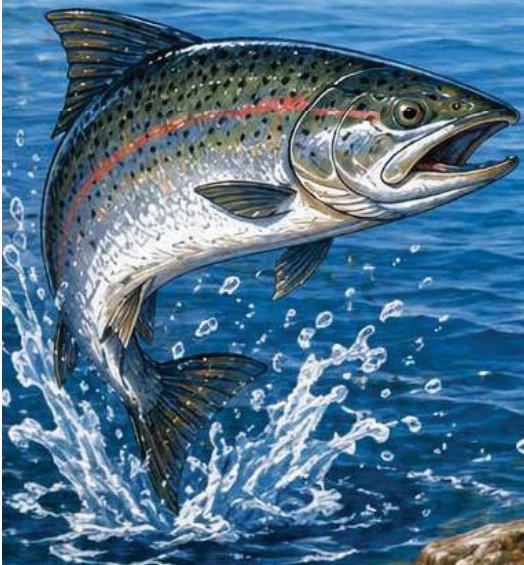

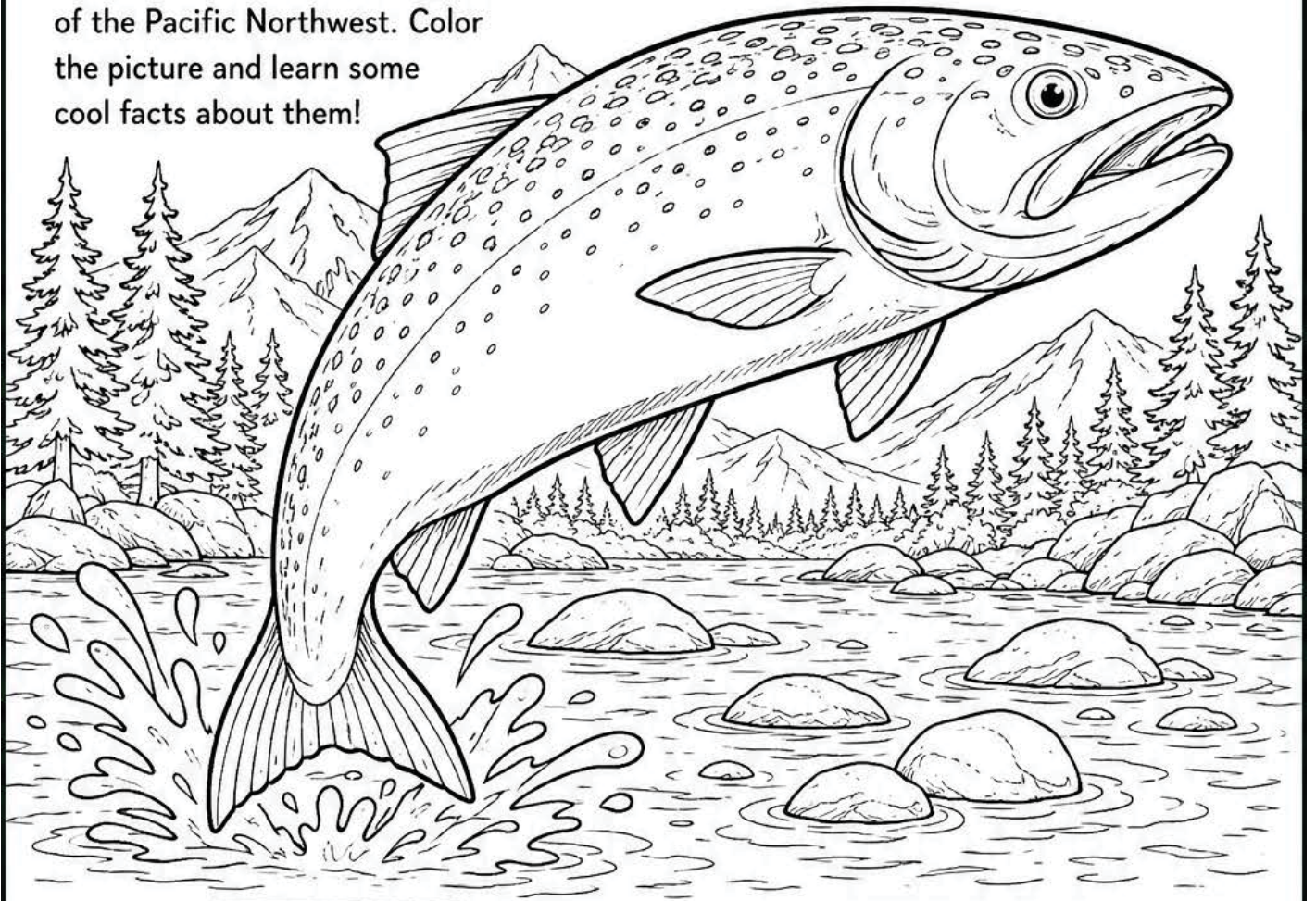

They can jump high to get upstream and reach the best places to lay their eggs.

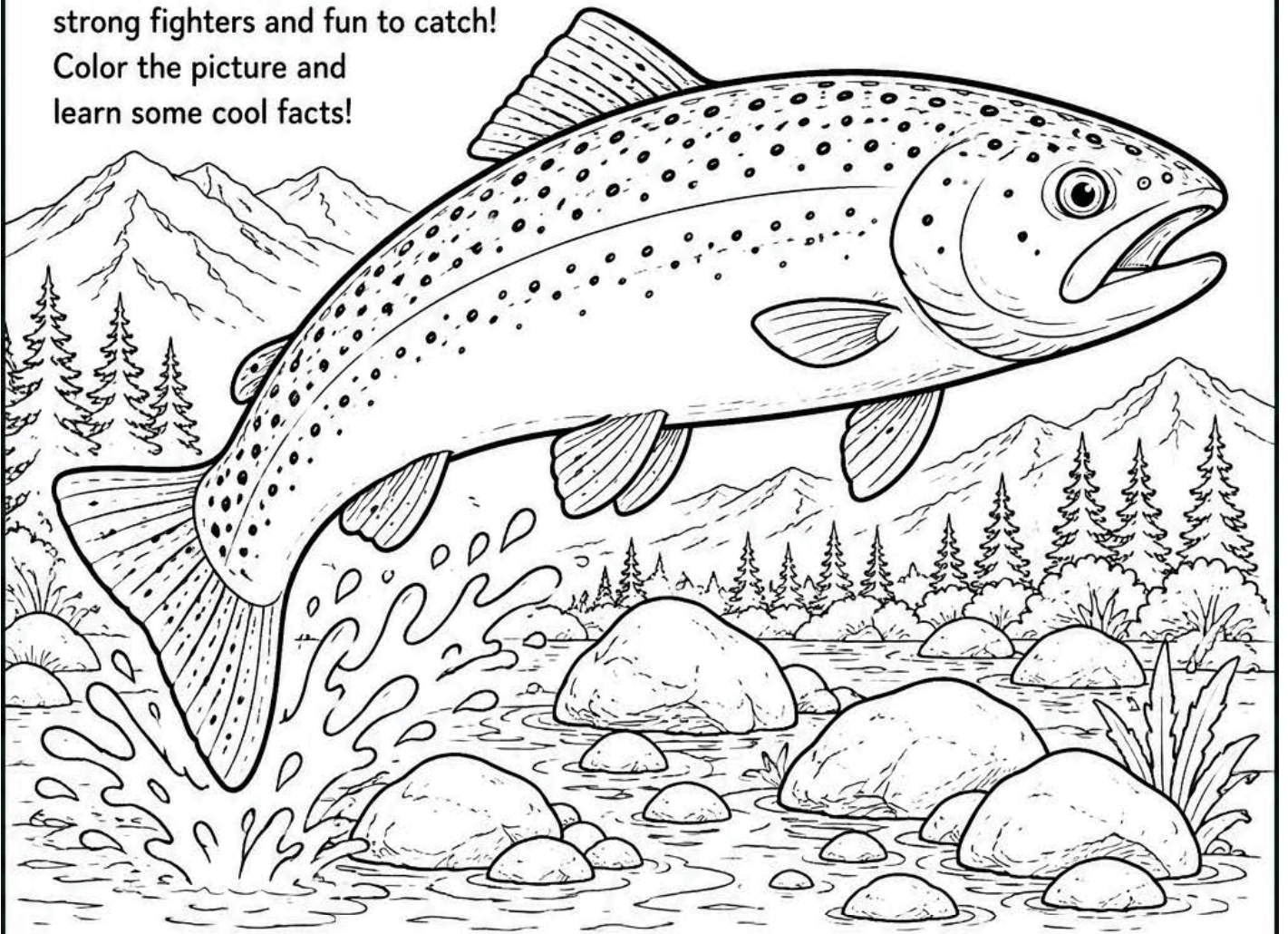


Coho salmon usually spend 2 to 3 years in the ocean before returning home.

all across the PNW.



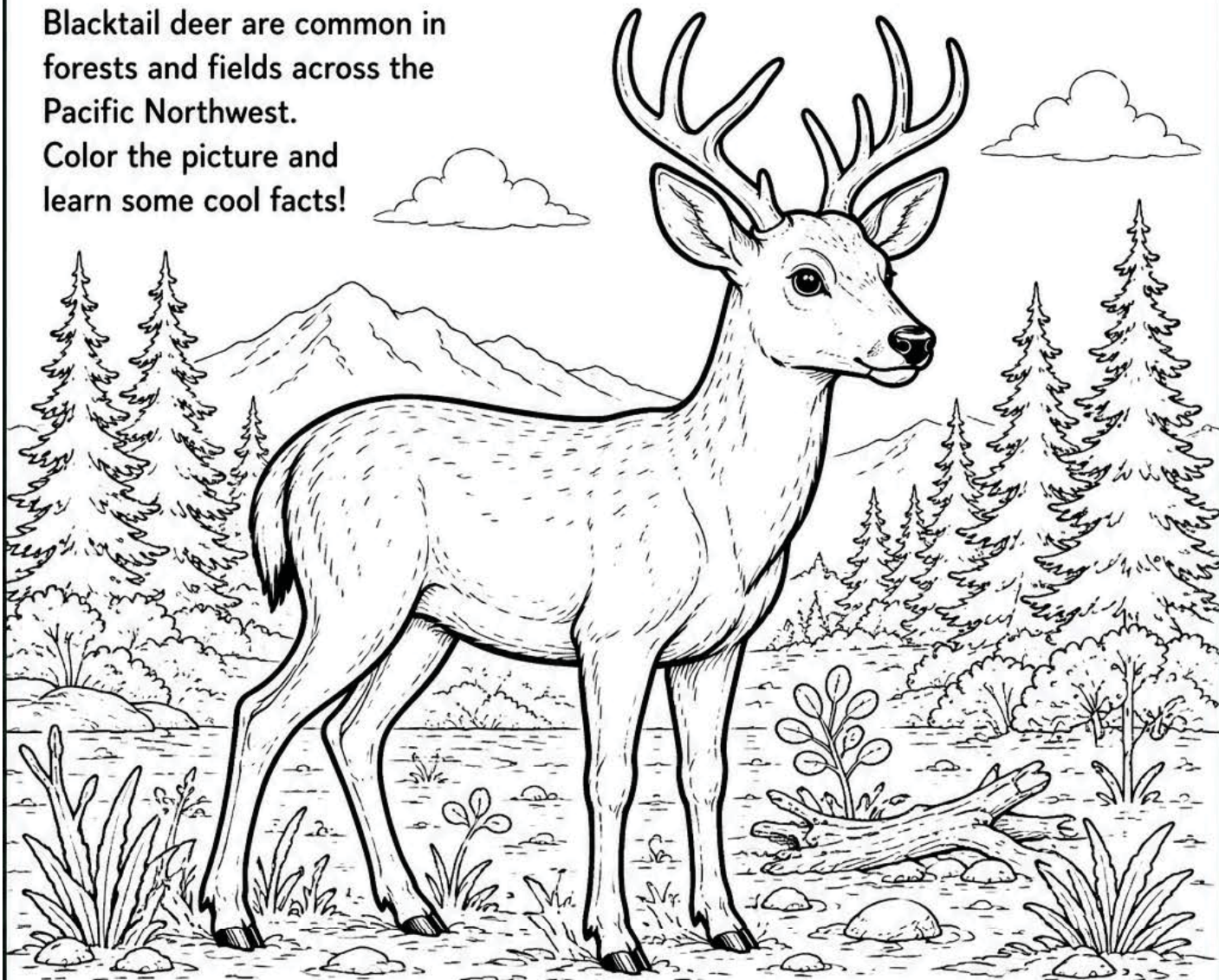
Can grow over

Have black tails with a white underside.

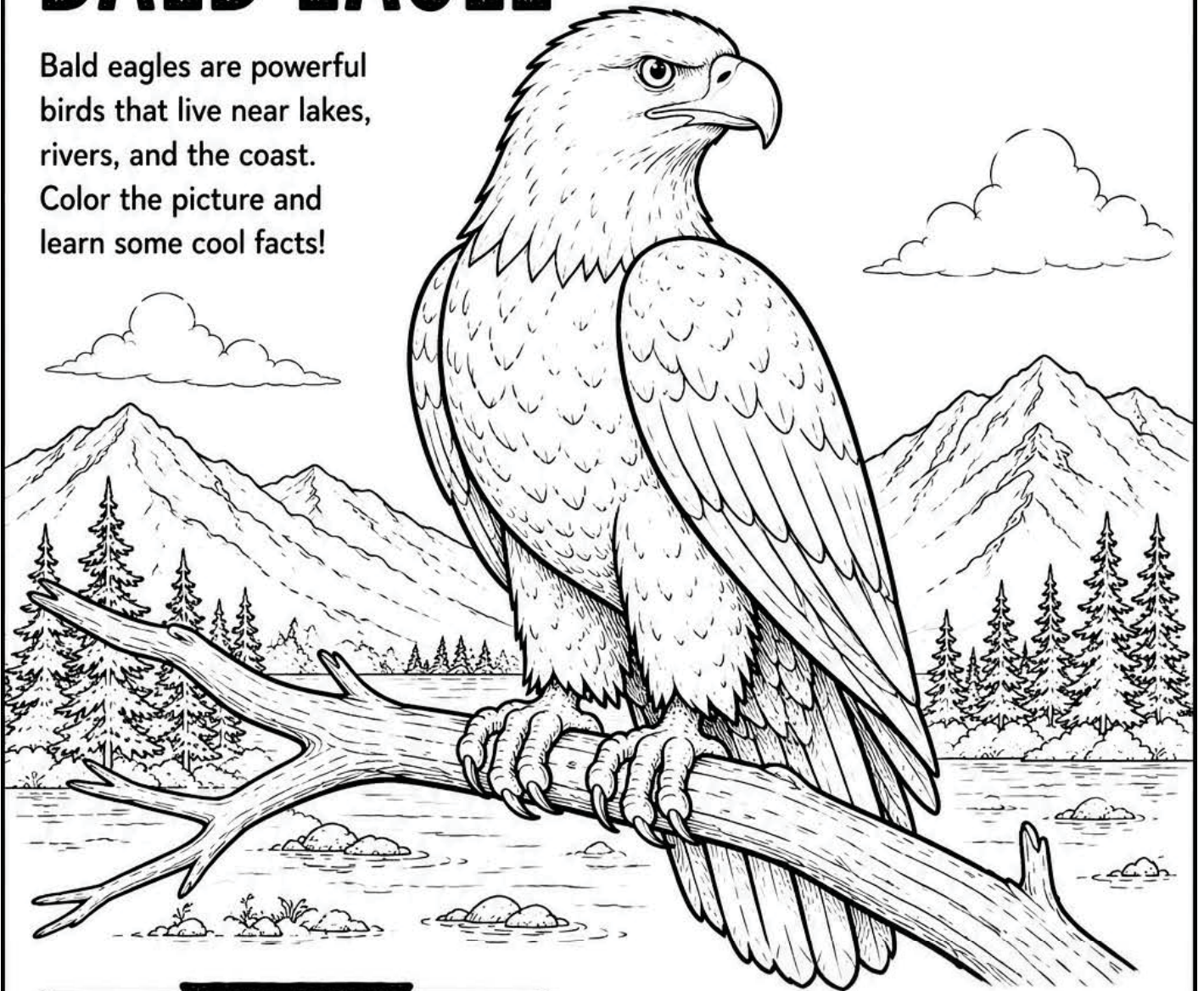


Eat leaves, berries, grass, and buds.



COLOR THE BALD EAGLE

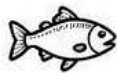
Bald eagles are powerful birds that live near lakes, rivers, and the coast. Color the picture and learn some cool facts!

Eagles build the largest nests in North America!

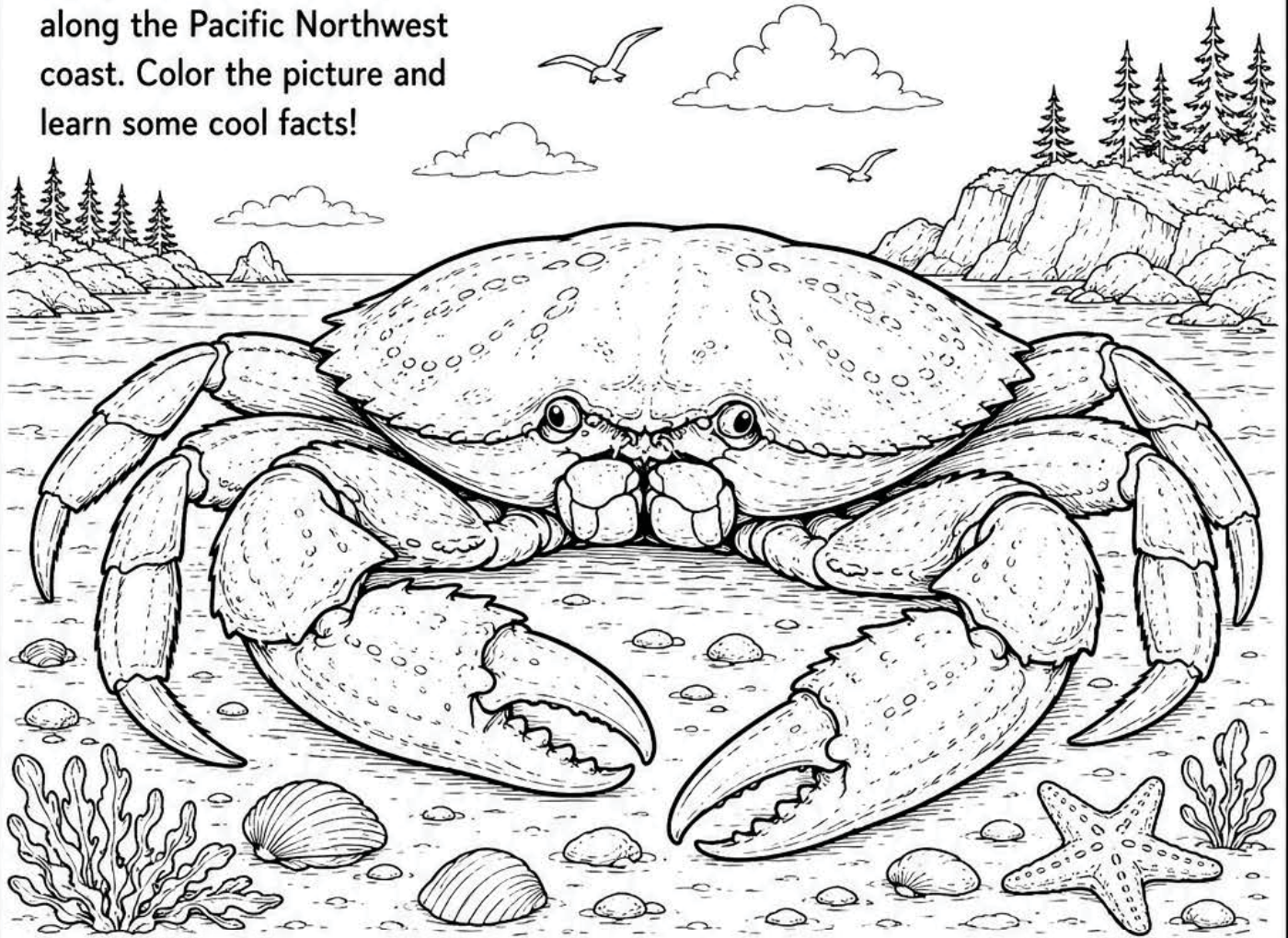


They can live up to 20-30 years in the wild.

They eat clams, worms, small fish, and other sea creatures.

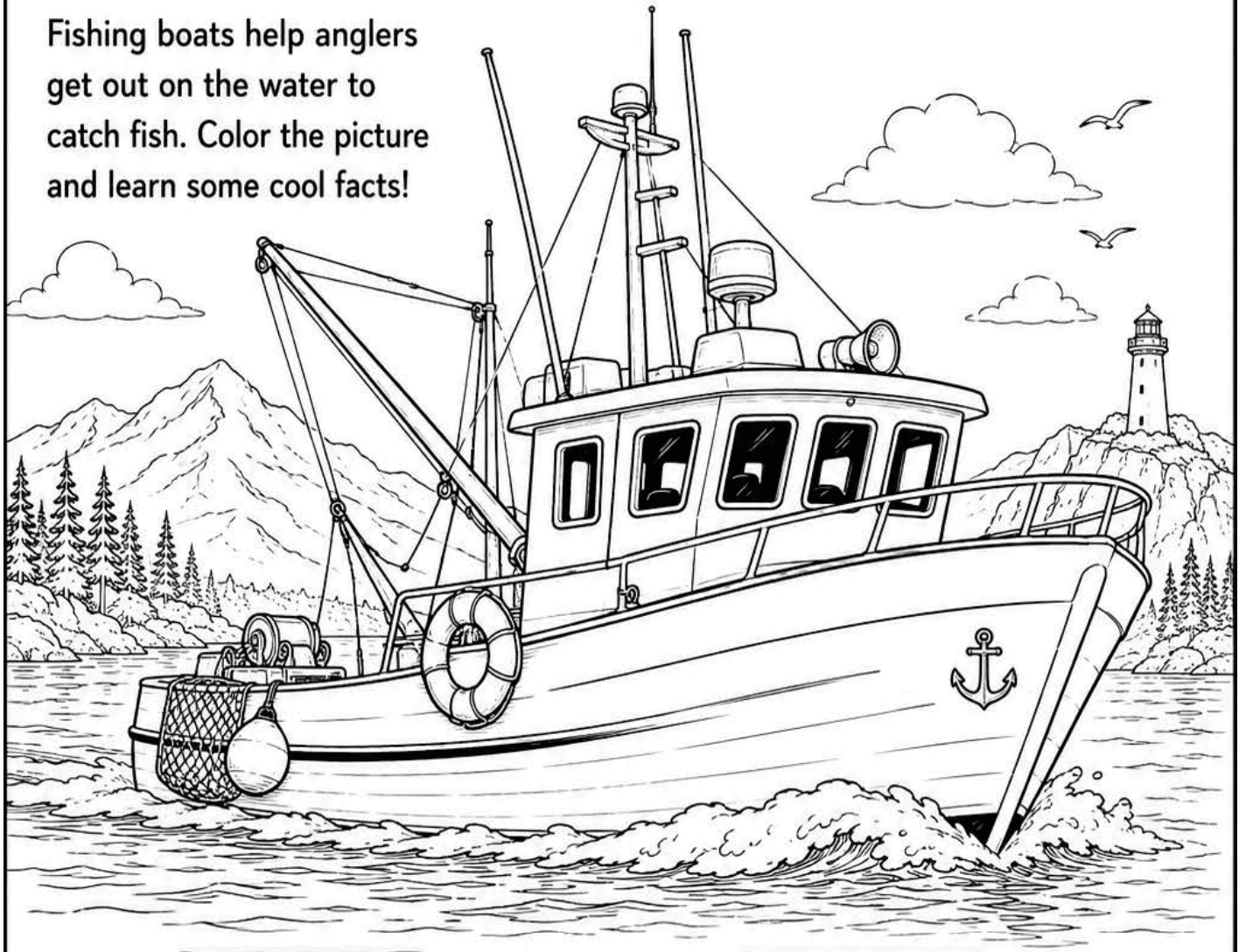


They can grow up to 10 inches across their shell!

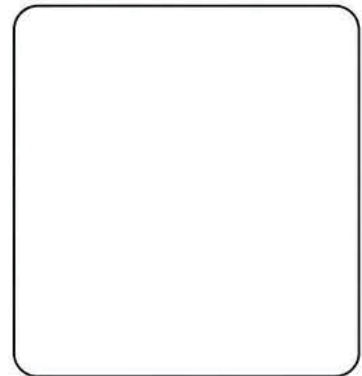

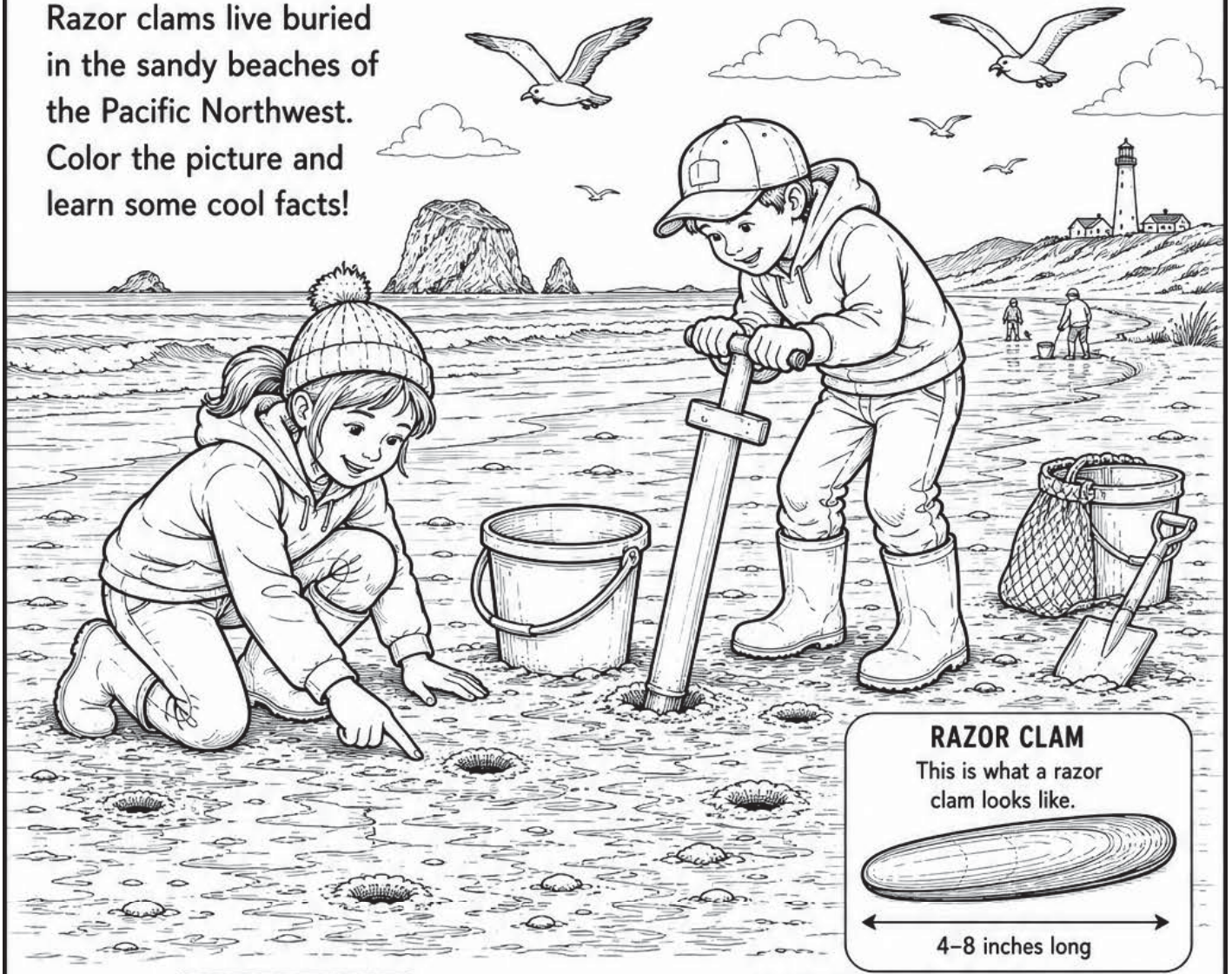
